









Planning and Production Process:

My planning process began with the illustration of a comprehensive mind-map that visually organised initial information and ideas regarding the Semi Formal Dress Hire web application. The GUIs and pages of the web application were deigned in 'PENCIL', and this served as the fundamental basis for the developed website. There were several features of the design that were not incorporated into the developed solution, most prominently; the 'staff page' which was planned to display all current orders and there relevant information to staff, the editing of orders ('remove item') feature and, the 'gift code' feature. The omission of these features stemmed from a lack of knowledge on the storing and manipulation of user inputs and variables. The aesthetic design of the pages was also simplified in the developed solution.

Evaluation of Final Web application

The developed solution allowed users to submit a request for attire, 'add to cart' items that are displayed with an image and brief description, and 'checkout'. The final web application also incorporated features not included in the original plan. During the development of the application it became apparent that a 'home page', was necessary to allow users more effective navigation of the application. The home page featured a link to the 'request attire' page as well as a step by step instruction to the usage of the application. There were, however, several bugs, glitches, and limitations to the developed solution. In the future the web application could be improved by implementing the features recognised in the planning process. The design of the pages, noticeably the 'home' and 'checkout' features could be improved to be more aesthetically pleasing. A Side bar or breadcrumb trail could also be implemented to allow users clearer, and more effective navigation of the web application.
